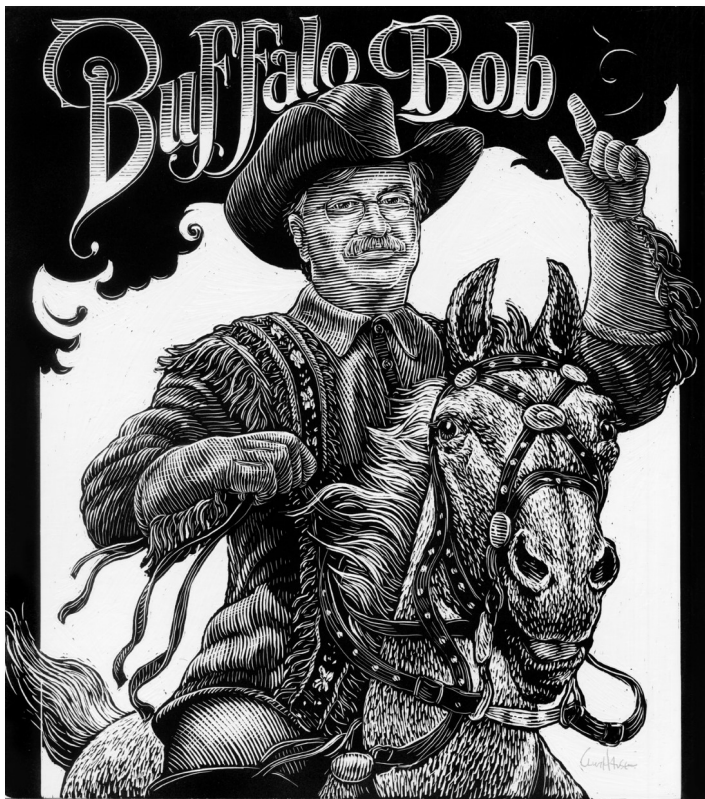
“Luck is a Fortune”

Dr. Pickering’s talk is based on two diaries found in the libraries at Gilcrease and University of Tulsa. He will describe what life was like for the soldiers at Fort Gibson in 1843, including a retelling of an adventurous Buffalo hunt they experienced in Central Oklahoma.

Bob Pickering, Ph.D. was the founding director of the master’s degree program in Museum Science and Management at the University of Tulsa. During the span of his career he has filled many roles in some of America’s finest museums, including the Field Museum of Natural History, the Children’s Museum of Indianapolis, the Denver Museum of Nature & Science, the Buffalo Bill Historical Center, and the Gilcrease Museum.
