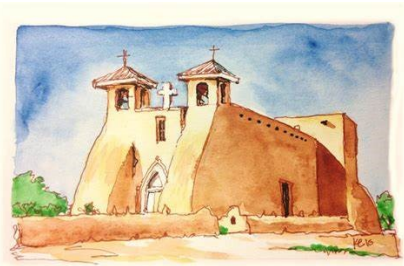

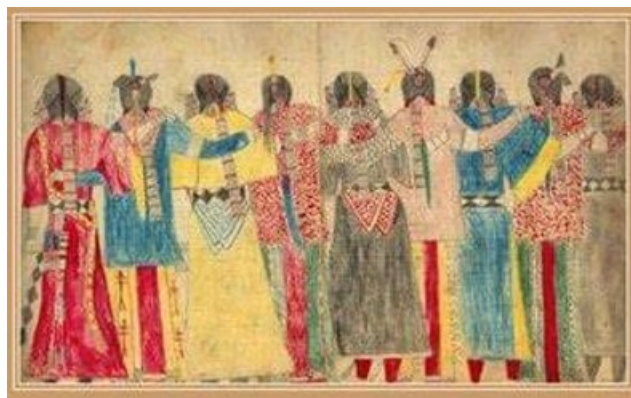
Tulsa's Earth Day Celebration
