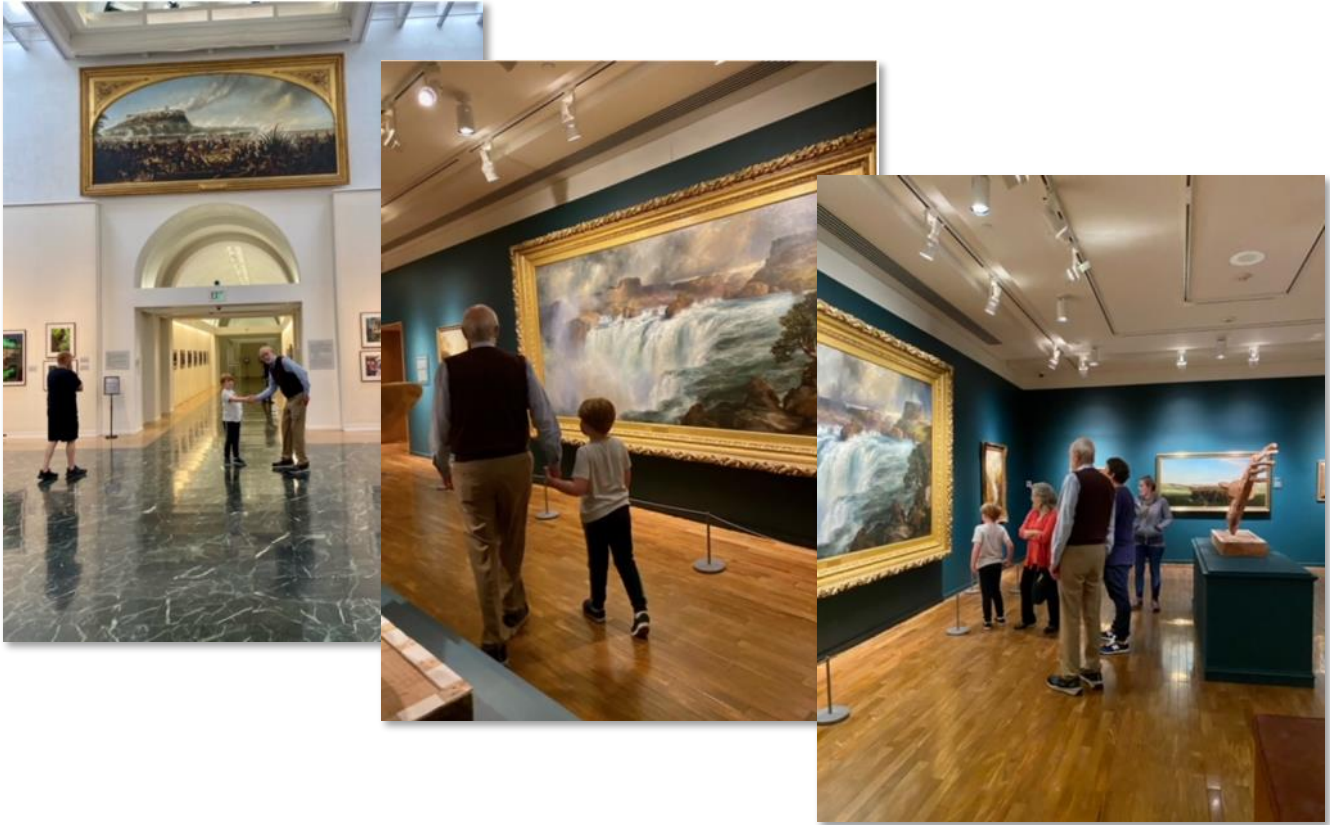
Come join us at this free USk (Urban Sketchers) Tulsa event, on **Saturday, June 26th**, where we will draw what we see. Free to participate!
