Isn't he the cutest? This is Asher, Marsha and Mark Gulick's newest Gypsy horse, Asher Whitewing CR. Asher had some medical issues at birth and is recovering at the OSU Vet Hospital. He should be home with his momma soon.

Gypsy horses were first bred by Irish Travellers and Romani of the UK and were used to pull their caravans. They are a fairly new horse breed (last half of the 1800s) and were refined in the years after World War II. They are on the smallish side for a draught horse, but like draught horses are known for being steady and calm. Marsha and Mark have several horses of this beautiful breed.
