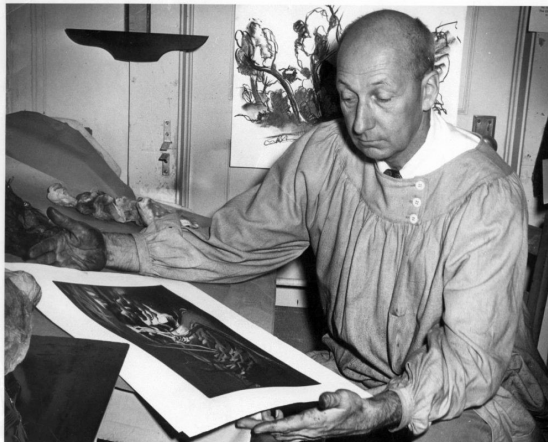
Travel Committee News
