The overall program stretches from Guthrie Green to the Living Arts building. Our table and activity will physically be in the Living Arts building.

Gillies will be assisting Alison Rossi and teaching artist Katie Ryan as they facilitate the papel picado craft. This will include helping with passing out materials, instructing guests on how to do the activity (all instructions will be provided), and helping to keep the table area neat and tidy. We will also be doing coloring pages and passing out colored pencil kits, so the Gillies will assist with that as well.

Alison Rossi will be your point of contact and will pass along any information regarding parking or other details when it is provided by our contact at Living Arts. Typically details such as this aren't sent out to partners until 24-48 hours prior to the event. When the Gillies arrive that day, they will tell the Living Arts staff member at the front that they are with Gilcrease and they will direct them to our table location.
