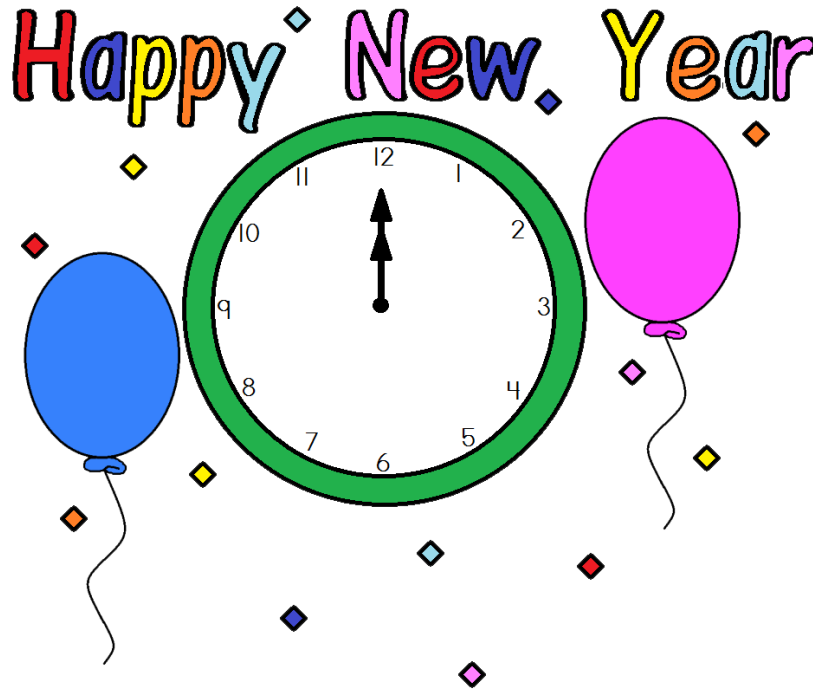

There will be no charge for Gillies and a \$3 charge for guests. The number for the tour is limited

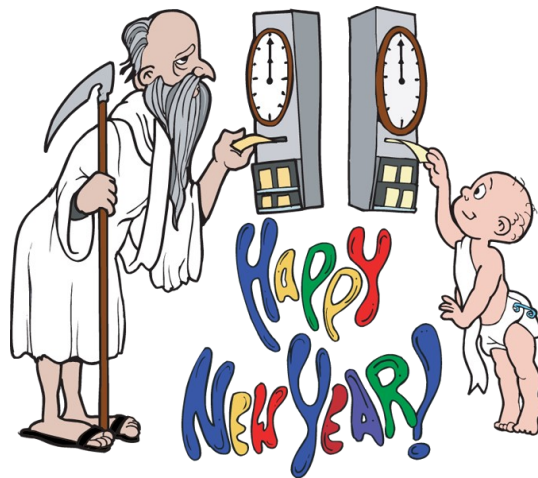
